The purpose of this scholarship program is to encourage and assist young men and women in the development of technical skills that will be required for job entry in a retail agricultural equipment dealership that is dedicated to provide Illinois' and Wisconsin's agricultural industry with modern, automated agricultural equipment and trained service technicians and personnel.

The scholarship applies to select one and two-year diploma and associate degree programs offered in training programs related to the sales and servicing of agricultural equipment offered at any of the community/technical colleges within the Wisconsin Technical College System and Illinois Community College System.

\$1000 scholarships to a community/technical college of the recipient's choice will be awarded. Midwest-SouthEastern Equipment Foundation scholarship program has three major objectives:

1. To provide assistance to rural youth in obtaining training and development in trades and skills that will increase their ability to serve agriculture through agri-business.
2. To encourage agri-business employers to look to community/technical college training programs as resources for the development of skilled technicians and personnel trained to serve the industry.
3. To encourage and promote the cooperative development of agri-business training in all rural-oriented post high school community/technical college training systems.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES

1. Applicants must comply with the admission requirements of their selected community/technical college.
2. Applicants must be interested in the retail agricultural equipment business and be a Wisconsin or Illinois resident.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of information provided on the application. The applicant must provide three letters of recommendation. The scholarship will be awarded for the current school year and the funds may be used only for school fees, books, equipment, and board and room. Scholarships may be subject to cancellation if, in the opinion of the school or the Administrative Committee, the student does not achieve satisfactory academic standards, changes in the basic course of accepted study, or wants to change schools. Each case will be individually reviewed. The recipient shall be chosen on the basis of relative scholastic achievement and of special promise and aptitude in their chosen field.
4. The scholarship funds will be placed with the Wisconsin Technical College System or the Illinois Community College System. The scholarship money will be awarded by check to the recipient upon registration and after attendance of three weeks of regular classes for Fall semester.
5. To apply for a scholarship:
 - (a) Fill out and submit the *Personal Information Form* by **April 1, 2019**.
 - (b) Submit a copy of a current high school transcript (or past high school transcript and a current community/technical college transcript if already attending a community college/technical school).
 - (c) Provide three letters of recommendation from such persons as former teachers or high school counselor, county agents, neighbor, or current employer.
6. Recipient will be notified of the scholarship award by a representative of the retail agricultural equipment industry during the month of May each year.
7. Selection of scholarship recipients shall be made each year by a committee consisting of at least three persons with at least one person from a retail agricultural equipment dealership and one from the staff of the Wisconsin Technical College System or the Illinois Community College System and one from the Midwest-SouthEastern Equipment Foundation.
8. **Application and recommendation letters must be received no later than April 1, 2019 to the Midwest SouthEastern Equipment Foundation, 5330 Wall St., Suite 100, Madison, WI 53718-7929.**
